Re: Inter-District Cooperative Agreement

Attached for your approval is a copy of the Inter- District Cooperative Agreement between Sno-Isle TECH Skills Center and the Stanwood-Camano School District. This is an ongoing agreement that is renewed annually and benefits the students in our district.

This agreement will be utilized in the case where it serves a student in their best interest to attend the skills center at Sno-Isle TECH Skills Center. Prior to a student enrolling at the skills center, it will be determined that the placement is in the best interest of the student without fiscally impacting the Stanwood-Camano School District. I have been assured that whether or not any student attends the skills center, there will be neither a participation fee nor other fees assessed to our school district.

Recommendation: That the Board approves the 2020-21 Sno-Isle TECH Skills Center Inter-District Cooperative Educational Services Agreement.

AGREEMENT
FOR INTER-DISTRICT COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES
2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

This agreement is hereby entered into by and between Sno-Isle TECH Skills Center, Mukilteo School District No. 6, Snohomish County Washington, collectively referred to as the “**SERVING DISTRICT**,” and Stanwood-Camano School District, Snohomish County, hereinafter referred to as the “**PARTICIPATING DISTRICT**.”

The purpose of this agreement is to utilize inter-district cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.335.160, RCW 28A.225.250, and Chapter 392-135 WAC, to provide educational programs not otherwise available to students residing in the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT** and to avoid duplication of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by the attendance of the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT’S** students in courses offered at Sno-Isle TECH Skills Center (SISC).

This agreement is for the 2020-2021 school year. The Board of Directors authorizes the **SERVING DISTRICT** to allow students, in school districts not in the SISC consortium, to enroll and participate in programs offered by SISC. SISC anticipates serving an estimated number of between 1-10 students from the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT** for the 2020-2021 school year, predicated upon space available. It is understood that students attending SISC from the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT** will be funded for all SISC classes up to a 0.6 full time equivalent (FTE) each or as determined in the omnibus appropriations act per RCW 28A.245.020. In addition, the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT** shall be required to pay a Minor Repair and Maintenance fee to the **SERVING DISTRICT** per SB 5644 - 2017-18. The fee for the 2020-2021 school year is ten dollars (\$10.00) per Skills Center student annual average FTE and will be billed annually in August.

This agreement also provides SISC permission to access student address information from the data resource management center of the **PARTICIPATING DISTRICT** to be used for mailing newsletters, program brochures, summer school information, and student information.
