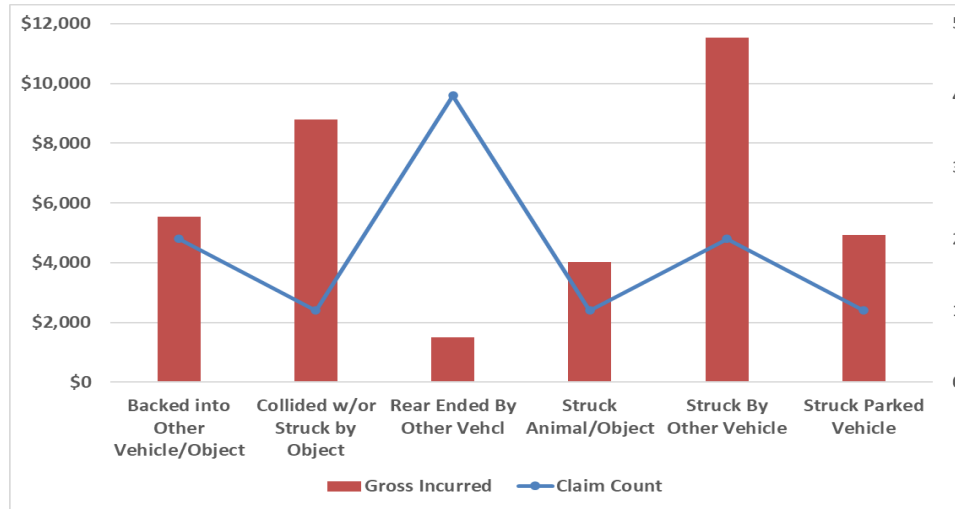

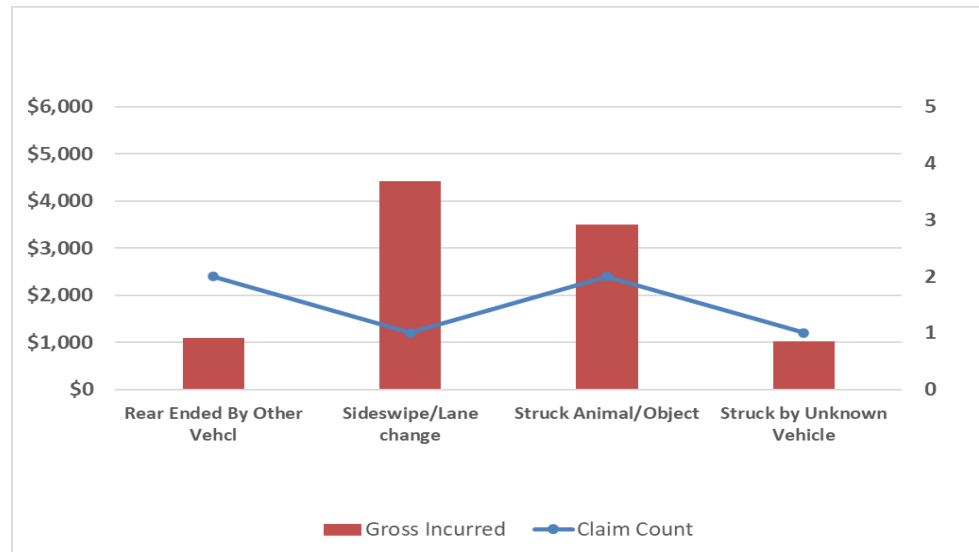

Auto Comprehensive and Collision (Bus) 2-24-17 through 2-24-22



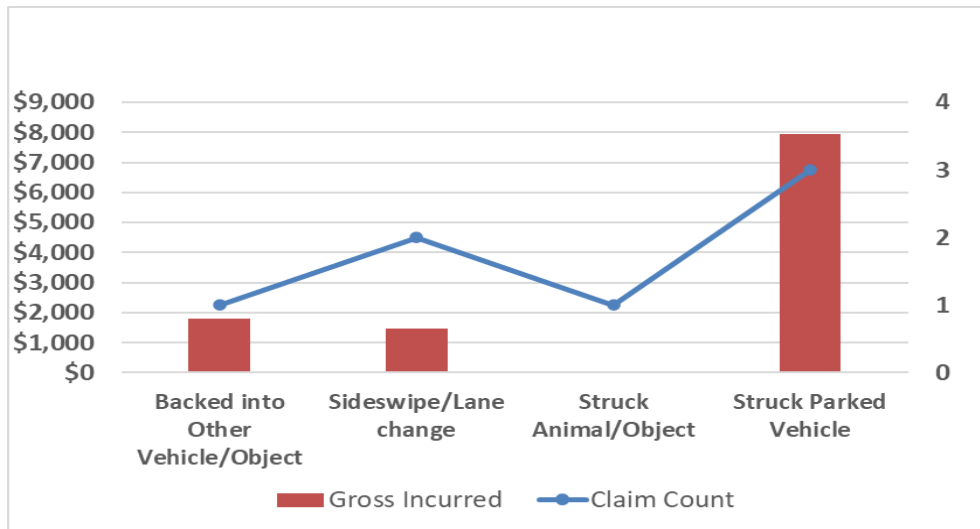

Auto Comprehensive & Collision (Non-Bus)



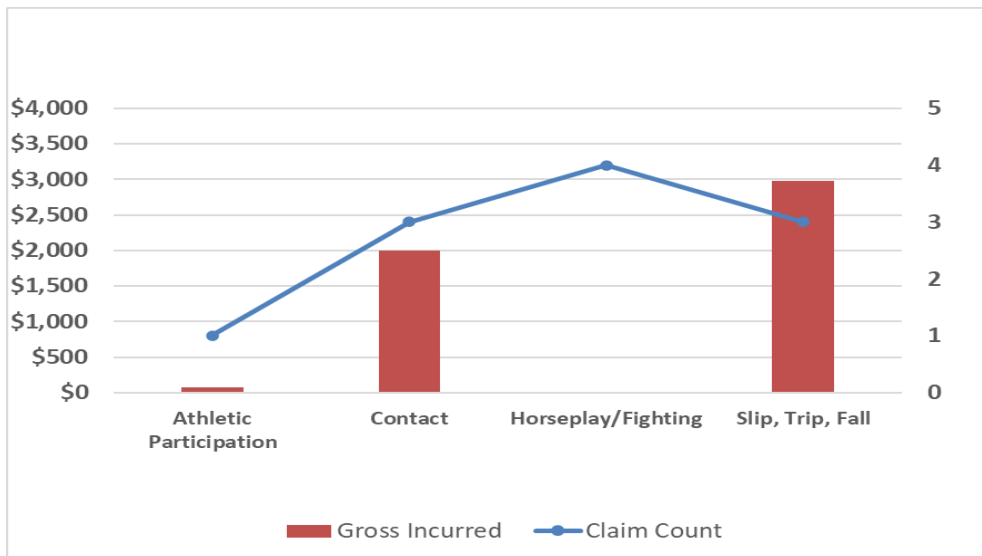

Auto Property Damage 2-24-17 through 2-24-22



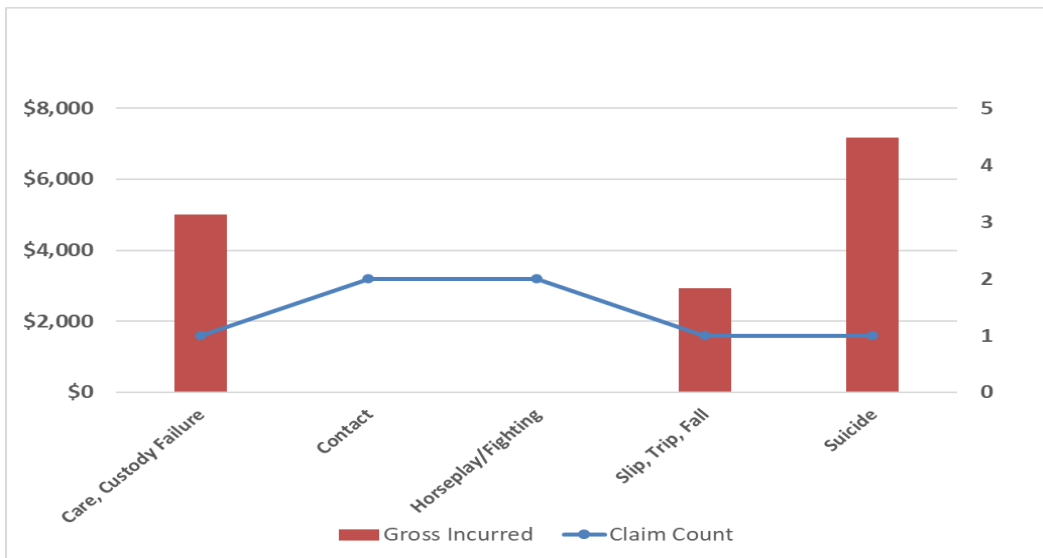

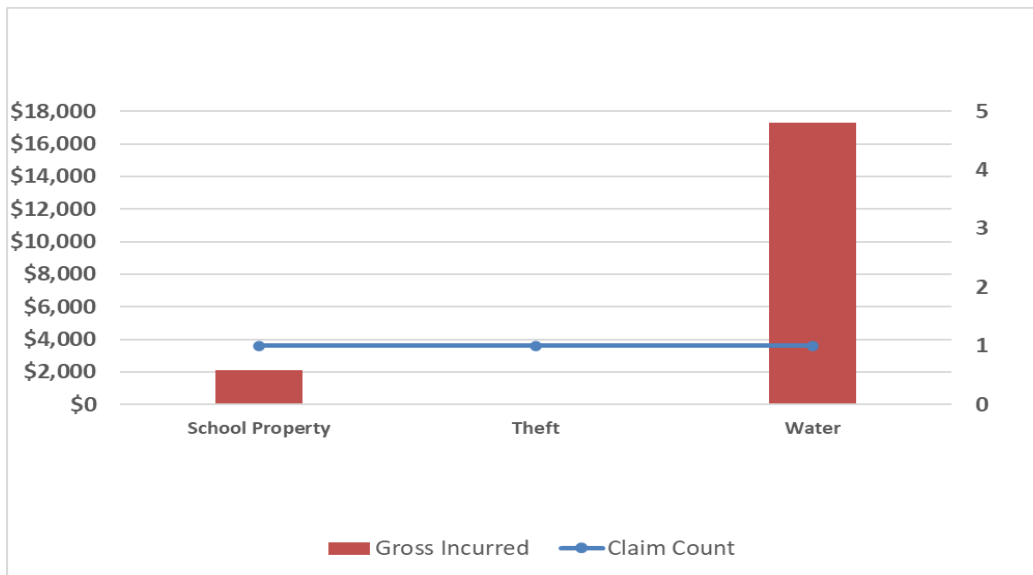

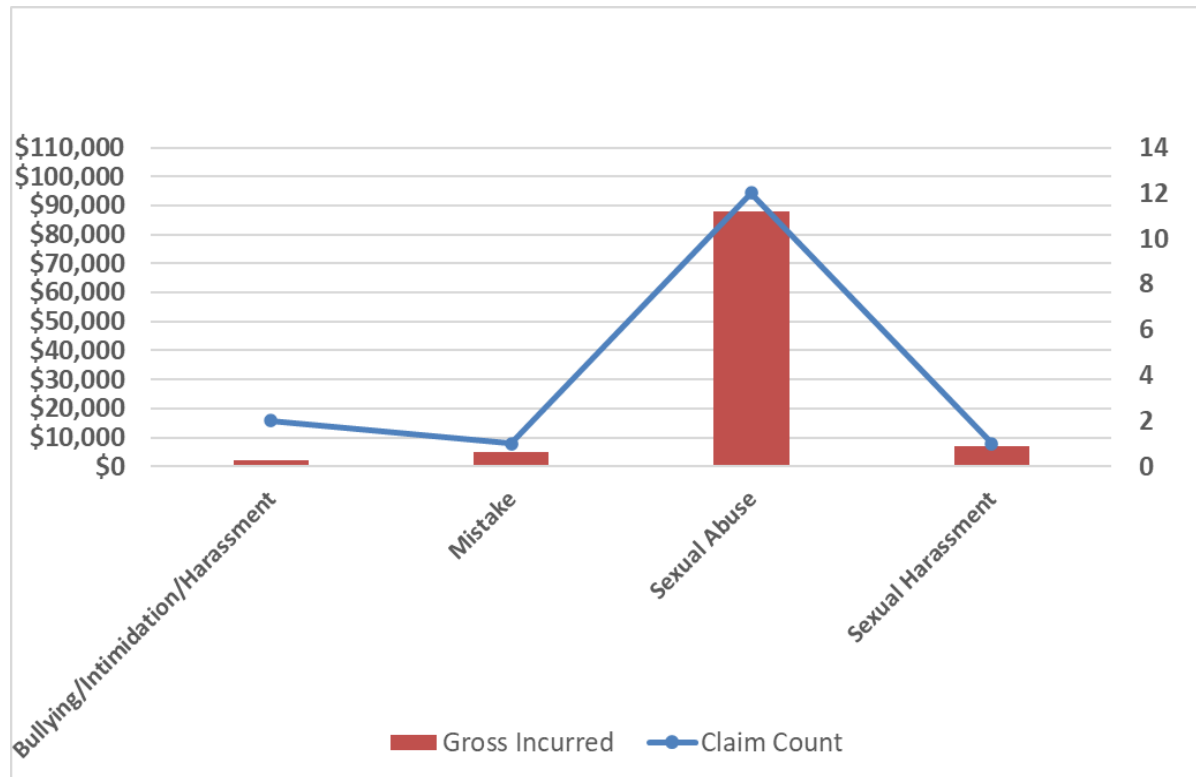

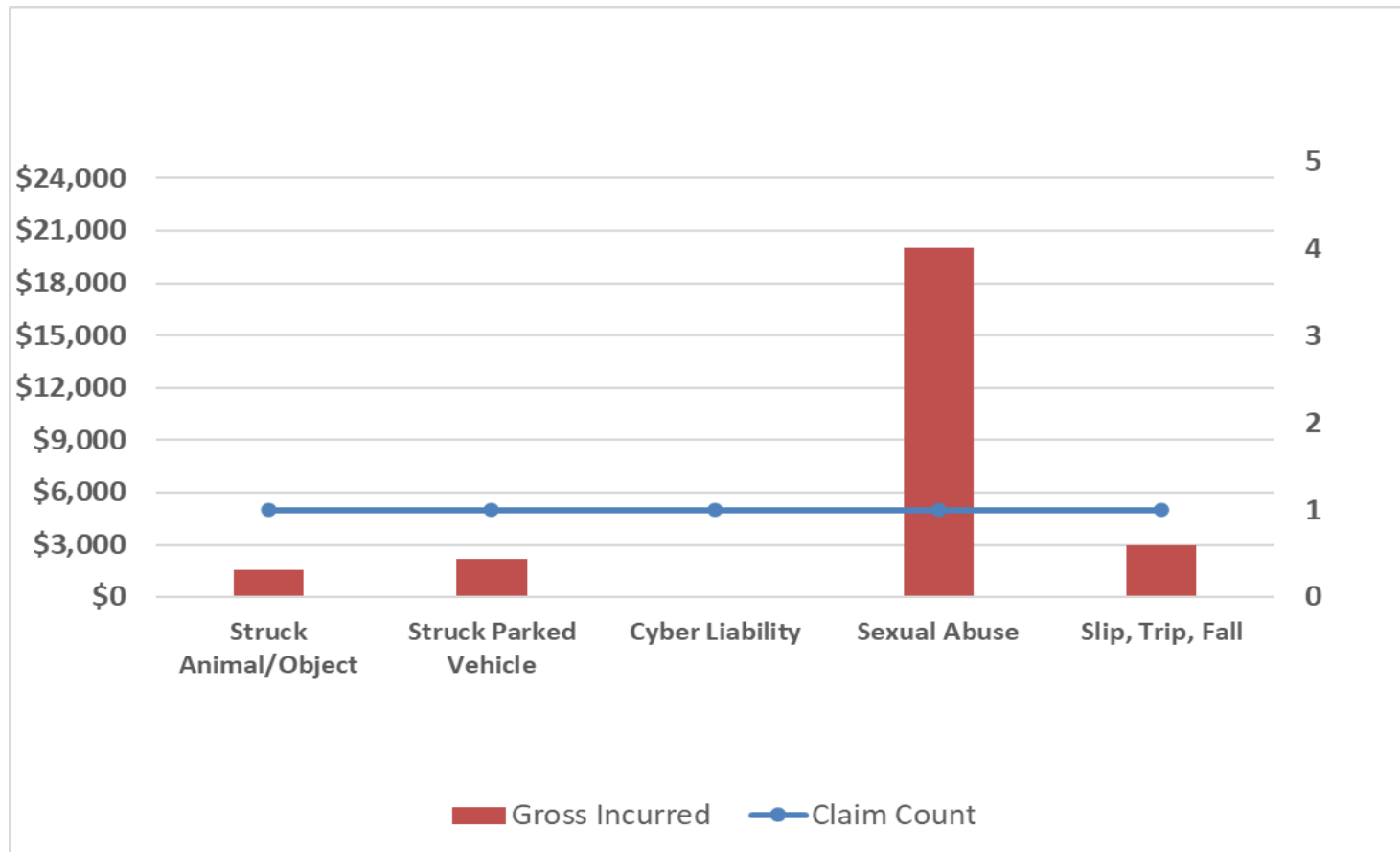
